COZMO – Ensemble Notes #18

In this Semester, pieces known to current **COZMO Ensemble** members will be introduced to new members. Players will also be learning new pieces and preparing for various COZMO performances during this Semester.

REHEARSAL 18 (2 December)

Present: Col, Trevor, Lindsay, Diana, Lea, Ben, Julie, Barbara. Absent: Di, Gianni (injured hand, returning Sem 1, 2019).

Our aim for the remaining 3 rehearsals this year, including today's, is to get to know the FAME Festival pieces and our 2 Rob Kay Tribute Concert pieces as much as possible prior to the Festival on Sunday 6 January 2019.

Today's rehearsal

1. Elegy and Wednesday's Child

We worked through <u>Elegy</u> and <u>Wednesday's Child</u>. In each, we are paying more attention to dynamics, but it is one of those things that will continue to improve the more aware we are of the difference that the proper use of dynamics can make to the overall beauty of the piece. The tempo changes in <u>Wednesday's Child</u> are flowing through pretty well now. More rehearsal should make them almost natural to us. WC!

2. Viaggio del Mandolino – Mvt 1: Preludio

We spent a few minutes on this just so that we are familiar with the entries. This whole piece shouldn't be a problem for any of the sections.

3. Fantasia Napoletana

COZMO Notes #16 covers this piece in detail – please review those comments.

We played through this piece section by section. The main things that we need to be on top of are the changes in **time**, **tempo** and **key**. The first two require you to watch the conductor carefully. The third requires you to watch your music and to be very familiar with playing in those keys. So, three big tips:

- Highlight all key changes, tempo and time changes so that you don't miss them.
- At home, mark sections that give you fingering or timing problems & work on them slowly & carefully
- Practise your scales especially those in the keys with flats; they are not guitar- or mandolin-friendly!
 See the table below for which scales to practise before you start to practise each piece!

We will all have to work on bars 118 through to 181 to make sure of our fingerings and accuracy.

4. Il Mandolini e Congresso

COZMO Notes #15 covers this piece in detail – please review those comments.

I'd suggest trying to play this at home with the video of Chris Aquavella's group, even if you have to slow it down a little: https://youtu.be/Ch43BSFEXsA.

As with <u>Fantasia Napoletana</u>, there are key changes, tempo and timing changes. So: **highlighting**, **counting and watching the conductor are all ESSENTIAL**.
