We used today to again work on the Pleyel piece – Mvt 1 (*Allegro*) and Mvt 2 (*Romanze*). Following last Session's format, we again played through these first two movements, phrase by phrase, to build on what we had achieved last Session: familiarity, maintaining the tempo, counting etc. Thank you for your concentration & hard work again today!

As we worked on the same movements – 1 and 2 – today as we'd worked on in our previous Session, there's no need to recap here.

Some music housekeeping: Please make sure that for next Session, you will all:

- have ALL pages of ALL gig pieces in a black folder (ready for the gig!), in GIG ORDER. You don't need any other music in that folder.
- ➤ have NUMBERED every bar in every piece
- have written in the SECTION LETTERS where we have amended them (e.g. in the Pleyel we scrapped all their printed letters and just have 'A' and 'B' in Mvt 1, etc!)
- ➤ are fully aware of the ARRANGEMENT (write it at the top of each piece/movement!) of each piece and each movement (3 mvts in the **Telemann** piece: 2, 4 and 6, the Allegro '1', Largo and Allegro '2' in the **Barbella** piece, and the Allegro, Romanze and Rondo in the **Pleyel** piece).

- > Play through the set-list each day, in set-list order. Include in your practice to pretend you're:
 - looking at Col for the final bar of each movement and each piece, and
 - watching him give us the count-in for each next piece (write at the top of each of your pieces).
- > Then focus on particular bars/phrases in the pieces you know need particular work.
